Retouching Colors Workshop Roberto Bestetti

20|21 Conservação e Restauro, a Portuguese contemporary art conservation studio, has invited Roberto Bestetti to teach a two day workshop aimed at conservators

Overview

The aim of this Masterclass is to provide information and materials for the preparation of two complete retouching color sets, one with Laropal A-81 and the other with Acquazol or Arabic Gum.

Topics will include:

- Presentation of international bibliography on the subject
- Foreword on mineral and organic pigments, ASTM Ligh fastness, selection of pigment.
- Foreword on binding media
- Water-based colors: preparation of a color set with Arabic Gum
- Resin-based colors: summary of principal characteristics of resin used for retouching (Natural terpenes like Dammar or Mastic, acrylic resins, low molecular weight resins)
- Preparation of 30 colors set with Laropal A-81 (Gamblin Conservation Colors medium)

Workshop

During the course two color palettes will be prepared hand grinding binders and pigments: one with Laropal A81 as binder, and one with arabic gum. All the participants will receive a complete set of 30 colors, 5ml each, of watercolors and a complete set of 30 Laropal A81 retouching colors.

The colors produced in the workshops include minerals, organic pigments and micaceous pigments for gold retouching, so the colors produced can be useful to those who have to carry out interventions on ancient, modern, contemporary and for wood conservator.
