You may have been aware of the memorial event we staged in Chelsea on Monday to remember Chris. It turned out to be a very good occasion - Oonagh and their children and various otherfamily members were there, and over 100 people came. In orderto create a spouvenir ofthe event for Oonagh we asked people to sign a guest book, with comments on Chris if they wished, and I thought that it would be nice to be able to include some of his closer colleagues who were not able to be there. I prepared some loose gatherings of a handmade paper made in 1938, the year Chris was born, for this purpose, and I wonder whether you might like to gather together signatures of people in Slovenia who knew Chris to be included. Oonagh has been greatly comforted to realise how well regarded and loved Chris was all over the world, and this would be one way of including Ljubljana in this. We showed pictures of Chris on a loop during the event, several of which showed him giving classes in Ljubljana. I would be happy to post a copy ofthe keepsake we prepared - where should I send this?

We also launched a crowd-funding appeal to raise money to complete the project to digitise his 30,000 slides and put them on-line, and money, I am happy to say, is beginning to come in.
